I was recently honored by Dek Unu (the number "11" in Esperanto) Magazine when they chose my photographs (from 700 photographers who submitted portfolios) to be the subject of their entire (40 page) October issue.

This portfolio, entitled "A Fair of the Heart – 50 years of photographs of the NC State Fair" includes black and white, square format images from the 70's, as well as contemporary color images, and includes an extensive interview about my life.

The interview introduces you to many of the fascinating people who I have known and who have inspired my artwork, including the Surrealist collector and impresario Edward James, who amassed the world's largest personal collection of surrealist art, and built his own concrete Xanadu in the lush tropical jungles of Mexico. He was the subject of an hour-long documentary film (Edward James: Builder of Dreams) that I produced and directed, and premiered at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and was later shown on PBS.
